## SINGLE PARENT RESEARCH

The research is being conducted through Queensland University of Technology as part of a PhD candidature through the School of Justice, Faculty of Law.

<b>What is the study about?</b>	The study is about single parents' experiences of single parenthood, specifically in relation to social attitudes
<b>What people are needed for the study?</b>	Anyone who identifies themselves as a single parent, for example: single mothers; single fathers; LGBT single parents; Indigenous single parents; single parents with a disability; single parents with children with a disability; working single parents; single parents on welfare; single parents by choice; teenage single parents etc.
<b>What will involvement with the study mean?</b>	Single parents will be interviewed either face-to-face (if living in South East Queensland), by telephone, or through the internet.
<b>Aims of the study:</b>	To promote awareness of the needs and strengths of single parents
<b>Why is this study important:</b>	Social attitudes impact on the choices and opportunities available to people. By highlighting the negative and positive social attitudes regarding single parenthood a greater awareness and understanding of the needs and strengths on single parents can be enabled.
<b>How will the findings from the study be reported:</b>	The results of this study will be published through academic journals and conferences and as part of a final Thesis for PhD qualification. A brief report on the findings will be made available to participants upon completion of the study.
