FAMILY FORT HIDEOUT!

Kids need a place to be kids. So, why not show them how it's done?! Pitch in to help them create they're own special hideout out of old wood and cardboard boxes.

YOU WILL NEED: Cardboard boxes, Tree branches, Zip ties, Tape, Scissors, Green paint, Brown paint, Foliage, Rope or Twine

HERE'S HOW: **Have an adult help you with this craft**

- 1 Open up boxes at the seam lay them all our flat on the ground. Create walls and a rooftop by taping them together into the shape of a box.
- 2 Use the tree branches to stabilize your walls by zip tying them to each of the four corners of your box. This is the main room of the fort.
- 3 Place the last cardboard piece on the top to make the roof, then zip tie it to the tree branches.
- 4 Cut out the windows and doors, then paint wood plank texture to the outside and place foliage on the rooftop.
